

SET-UP AND RISERS



Location of FOH: the main console should be located **facing** the stage, about 20 m away, depending on the venue. We will not accept the main console on the stage or to the side of the stage.

The band needs two hours to perform a line check after everything is connected and working.

Risers needed for all set-ups

- 1 RISER FOR **CONGAS**, **DRUMSET AND BOMBO**, 7m x 2.40m x 0.60m
- 1 RISER FOR **KEYBOARDS** 1.2m x 2.40m x 0.20m
- 1 RISER FOR **BRASS SECTION** 2.40m x 2.40m x 0.20m

PERSONNEL

We will need an on-site sound technician and stage technician. For this event, we will be traveling with our usual engineers, but the assistance of the sound, light and backline providers is always invaluable.

LIGHTING

The lighting technician will arrive with advance production to set up lights. The equipment should be ready to start mapping during the sound check.

ARRIVAL

Please provide detailed directions with the venue's complete address and a contact phone number. We need a safe parking spot available for the bus close to the venue. Please provide us with arrival times for the sound check and when the doors will open for the event. The promoter or other contact person must be at the venue at the time of our arrival.

TRAVEL ALLOWANCE

We request cash travel allowances (\$50 outside of Colombia) per day per crew member, which should be delivered to the manager after the band's arrival in the city.

BACKSTAGE FOOD AND BEVERAGES

- · 12 regular meals and 2 vegetarian meals (without meat, chicken, or fish), or \$15 per person to purchase a meal.
- · At least 24 bottles of still water, at room temperature, for the stage and dressing rooms.
- · At least 12 liters of other cold beverages (juice, beer, Coca-Cola)

- · 1 bottle of whisky or rum
- · Some fresh fruit and granola bars
- · Ice

If we are going to spend the night in the city where the event is taking place, breakfast for 16 people for the morning after the show.

BACKSTAGE

Simply a room, tent, or separate space where the band and crew can rest a bit before and after the show (dressing room). It would be nice to have some couches, tables, chairs, a mirror, and a sink (ideally a bathroom). Electricity to connect computers, cell phones, and radio equipment.

OVERNIGHTS

If we have to spend the night in the city where the event in question is taking place, we request a warm, clean, dark, and quiet area for 16 people with beds, bathroom, shower, and mirror. Maximum two people per room. We must have a parking spot for the bus close to the place where we will spend the night.

MERCHANDISE

A table approximately 1.5 m long and a small light or some candles to display our merchandise at the show, if possible.

EXTRAS

A 20-person guest list.
